28th March – 1st April 2010

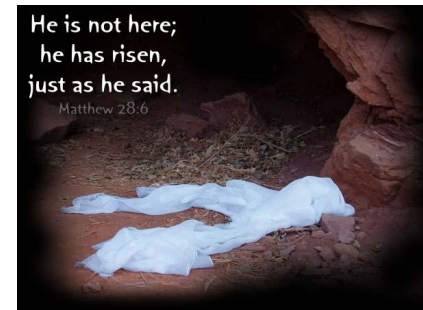
